Course overview

Express your musical creativity and develop your songwriting skills in a supportive online group. This course will explore how to put together multi-track songs using recording software. Learners can choose to use their own recording software, or create an account for SoundTrap, a free online recording platform. During the course we will also analyse different song genres and learn to identify different instrument parts within an existing song. Please note: This is an advanced level course and requires existing skills in order to take part.

Course description

Learners taking part in this course will create their own song using recording software. The course will explore how to put together multiple different instrumental/vocal tracks, before downloading your song as a 'finished' mp3. Learners can choose to use their own recording software, or create an account for SoundTrap, a free online recording platform. You will find it a lot easier to take part in this course if you have a keyboard with MIDI capability, but live recording of instruments is also an option. We will also analyse and break down existing songs to understand their individual components and how they may have been recorded/put together, as well as exploring the identifying features of different song genres and deciding whether we want to stick to them or not!

Please note, this is an advanced level course which requires students to undertake more challenging activities. Your tutor will do an initial assessment with you at the start of the course to confirm suitability. If you have never used recording software before, you may struggle to follow/keep up with the course, although students with good IT skills may be able to pick it up.
