ESOL entry 3 courses build on skills you learnt at entry 2. Gain confidence speaking in new and familiar situations and learn tools for effective communication. This is an English course for adults. It is

aimed at speakers of other languages. ESOL classes are divided into three areas: reading, writing, and speaking & listening. If you're helping others access ESOL courses in the UK, you've come to the right place.

Course description

This is an ESOL skills for life Entry 3 speaking and listening course. You will continue to develop your verbal communication skills.

This course is for students who have previously learned with us or who have been assessed by our team and supported to join.

This course will help you to improve your speaking and listening skills in everyday conversations and situations. We will look at grammar and vocabulary and how we use them in conversations. The course will be focused on group discussions and group work which will not only help improve your English but make friends with other learners.

- 1. Follow the gist of a discussion on a known topic
- 2. Make 2 or more contributions to a group discussion on a known topic
- 3. Ask and answer 2 or more open questions about a known topic
- 4. Listen to a conversation and answer 3 or more gist questions
- 5. Listen to a conversation and answer 3 or more questions asking for detail.
