You will need to be able to state and justify why you have used certain materials, skills, and techniques to make your pieces. You will explore what you enjoy making and how you can continue to develop your individual techniques and skills. You will have the opportunity to suggest what you want to cover during the course and bring ideas to the class. You will be expected to finish at least one piece of your work and state how you made it.
