Course description

On this course you will explore the qualities of different fabrics and understand more about how to work with them. Start to learn to use a sewing machine to create seams, darts, facing and neck lines.

Learn to make a simple garment and produce some samples, recordings and photos for your folder (online and on paper) every week.
