Please note that you'll need an internet connection to study this English course in Writing. This is so you can access our digital learning platform, Canvas. We use Canvas for homework, and also for tasks and activities in the classroom.

Course description

This is an ESOL course for adults. Before you can enrol on this course, you will need to do a skills check. This is for us to make sure you get on the right course for your level. This course is for people working at Entry 3 level ESOL.

This course will help you to improve your English in all skills – reading, writing, speaking and listening – but the focus will be on speaking and listening

You must be able to ask and respond to questions about everyday situations, follow a short conversation and talk using different tenses (past, present and future).

There are 5 learning outcomes on this course. You will need to achieve these outcomes in order to pass the course. You are expected to attend the classes regularly and be punctual. You are expected to participate in class and complete any homework given by the tutor.

On this course you will learn to:

- ask and answer questions in familiar situations.
- use suitable phrases to give your opinion clearly in a discussion
- respond to other people's contributions in conversation
- use the present perfect tense to talk about experiences
- listen for and identify detailed information in a text
