This is an ESOL skills for life level 1 speaking and listening course. You will continue to develop your verbal communication skills.

You need some prior knowledge to take this course, that's why you'll do a skills check to enrol. Don't worry, this isn't an exam. It's for us to make sure you get on the right course for you.

Our friendly team will contact you to start your skills check as part of your booking.

When you complete this module, you can continue with other ESOL skills for life level 1 courses. Once you finish the reading, writing, and speaking & listening courses, you can progress to level 2 ESOL courses.

There are also "Get Ready" courses between each module to prepare you for the next course.

This ESOL level 1 speaking and listening course takes around 120 hours to complete.
