It will also get you started with some basic digital skills for communicating online. The tutor will help you to access learning activities in class and online and you will be able to work with others to practise your conversation skills. After this course, you can go on to study English reading, writing, speaking & listening in a class that's the right level for you. You can study for formal qualifications in English. You can also move on to a digital skills or a maths course.
