- Understand prefixes and suffixes and how word families are built from one root
- Understand the difference between adverbs, nouns, and verbs when exploring word families
- Learn to identify and correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation mistakes in a text.

This is an ESOL skills for life entry 3 course for adults. You will continue to develop your writing skills.

You need prior writing skills to take this course, that's why you'll do a skills check to enrol. Don't worry, this isn't an exam. It's for us to make sure you get on the right course for you.
