Course overview

Develop your speaking skills with this non-accredited course. This English course is for speakers of other languages and is a face-to-face class in a local centre. This ESOL Speaking & Listening course is for people who want to learn English. It will help you start to do things more independently and communicate with other people in your community. You will be able to: - Recognise and state the alphabet letter names & the phonetic sounds; recognise and state numbers 1-20; greet, make simple small talk and say goodbye; respond to requests for personal and factual information; and start to learn how to ask basic questions.

Course description

This is a Pre- entry level English course for adults. You will start to develop your speaking and listening skills. It is aimed at beginners, so you do not need any prior knowledge.

When you complete this course, you can continue with other ESOL courses at this level. Once you finish the reading, writing, and speaking & listening courses, you can progress to entry 1 level.

There are also “Get Ready” courses for each skill to prepare you for the next course.

This ESOL Speaking & Listening course takes around 48 hours to complete.

Please note it will be helpful if you have an internet connection for this English course for beginners. This is so you can access our digital learning platform called Canvas.
