Course overview

This Conversational English for Intermediate Level course is designed to help learners improve their fluency, confidence, and communication skills in everyday English conversations. This course is for you if you have a basic understanding of English and want to improve your speaking skills or are looking to boost your confidence in everyday English conversations. You will improve your fluency and conversational competence for personal interaction, work, study and everyday life. Building upon foundational knowledge, this course focuses on expanding vocabulary, enhancing listening and speaking abilities, and mastering common phrases and expressions used in real-world situations. This course offers interactive, engaging and fun activities in a friendly atmosphere.

Course description

This course is for second language speakers who have basic knowledge of English grammar and vocabulary and an ability to understand and participate in simple conversations.

Throughout the course, learners will engage in interactive activities such as role-playing, pair work, group discussions, and debates on various topics to promote active participation. The course will also cover essential communication strategies, including asking for clarification, expressing opinions, agreeing and disagreeing politely, and keeping conversations flowing smoothly. Phrasal verbs, idiomatic expressions, and common colloquialisms will be introduced to enhance language use. On this course you will develop your reading skills and feel more confident about reading authentic texts of different genres.

For intermediate learners, engaging in conversations regularly is key. Encouraging the use of richer vocabulary, new phrases, and more complex sentence structures will help boost confidence and fluency. By the end of the course, learners will have gained the skills and confidence to converse more effectively in a wide range of

situations, from casual discussions to more formal conversations. They will expand their vocabulary and use more specific, precise words. They will understand and incorporate phrasal verbs and idiomatic expressions.
