Course overview

This basic course will introduce learners to the world at work and the language needed to enter it. The course has been developed in partnership with West Bromwich Job centre but is open to everyone. The course will take place at CBO (Confederation of Bangladeshi Organisations) in West Bromwich. This course is particularly suitable for students who are unemployed and have been referred by Job Centres to improve their spoken and written English and thereby get closer to getting a job. This course is aimed at pre-entry ESOL learners.

Course description

This is a Pre-entry English course for adults. You will work on basic speaking, reading and writing skills to help you to enter into the workplace and to help build your confidence in using English. It's aimed at complete beginners so you don't need any prior knowledge.

You'll improve your basic spoken and written English and develop skills that will help you to get closer to the job market. You'll study basic English words and phrases and learn what are the essentials to get you ready to join an entry level course.

When you complete this module, you can continue with other entry level ESOL courses.

There are also "Get Ready" courses between each module to prepare you for the next course.
