You will be invited to read your work and have feedback in a constructive and friendly setting. We will have discussions on many aspects, such as shaping short stories, writing poetry, creating characters and using dialogue and description to make your work alive. We will consider some excerpts from published writers to assess and learn from their skills. There will also be short writing projects in class. Suitable for beginners and improvers. All you need is an interest in developing and enjoying creative writing skills. Work in progress can be brought to the first meeting but is not essential.
