The intent of the course is to ensure that learners are able to develop Artistic practices and skills which improve their physical and mental wellbeing, manual dexterity and personal effectiveness. adults with learning difficulties and disabilities who lived in supported living experienced greater isolation and struggled with independent living skills as there was limited access to support services and learning opportunities. Enabling them to acquire these manual, creative and self-reflective skills will support their personal development and give them the confidence for life and, potentially,

voluntary work.
