There are lots of hints and tips for staying safe online.

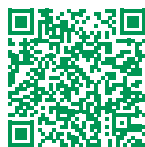
- ▶ Always be polite and respectful online
- ▶ Turn on your video so that your tutor can see you
- ▶ 'Blur' your background to keep your learning space private
- ▶ Mute your audio except for when you want to speak
- ▶ Wherever possible, use your first name only
- ▶ Send a message in Chat to your tutor if you need to leave the session
- ▶ Don't make audio or video recordings of your class
- ▶ Don't invite others to join the online session
