What is E-safety?

E-safety means the steps you take to keep yourself, your information and your devices safe

Do not share:

- Your email address
- **▶** Telephone number
- Passwords
- Use strong different passwords for accounts
- Use a password manager, (e.g. the Microsoft Edge password manager)
- Use 2-step verification (a password and a code sent to your phone)
- Always log out of websites once you've finished
- Lock your device
- Set privacy settings on social media
- Never open files or click on links you did not expect to receive
- ▶ If in doubt, block. Just say no to invitations from people you don't know
